How Can I Add Native Plants to My Landscape? It doesn't have to be all or nothing...

- Replace a dead plant with a native plant.
- Convert a part of current lawn into a wildflower meadow.
- Work out from property lines and edges.
- Establish native plant corridors with neighbors.
- Where would native plants be helpful? How about a rain garden for a wet area or native grasses for a hard to mow/maintain area?
- Not ready for native plants? Try lawn alternatives like EcoTurf, Buffalo grass or Blue grama grass. Stop mowing an area.
- Consider common areas, schools, community parks, etc.
